Current Reminders

- Please call your agent if you suspect you will have a claim on corn and beans once you start harvesting. Your trigger yield could be higher than what you think given the lower harvest prices for corn and beans.
- Bushels reported to crop insurance should match the bushels reported at FSA for the MFP program. Please report bushels to your crop agent as soon as you complete harvest. We can then print/email a copy of your production report for to have with you when you report production for the MFP program.

Approaching Deadlines

Harvest price established for corn, beans	10/1-10/31
Wheat final plant date for full coverage (N. Ohio)	10/20/18
Wheat last day of late planting period (N. Ohio)	10/25/18
Wheat production reporting deadline	11/14/18
Wheat acreage reporting deadline	12/15/18
Corn and beans end of insurance period	12/10/18
Deadline at FSA to file for MFP applications	1/15/19

Maximizing Market Facilitation (MFP) benefits at FSA

Discount schedules for delivering wet bushels to elevators and processors are usually different than federal moisture shrink charts. In order to maximize the benefits of the MFP, your wet bushels should be properly shrunk to federal charts. Below is a quick soybean example showing you just how many more bushels (and MFP benefits) you are eligible for by properly shrinking wet beans using federal shrink charts.

Wet Soybean Bushels delivered	Moisture	Federal Shrink Chart Dry Bushels	Elevator Dry Bushels	Difference	MFP soybean payment rate (\$1.65 bu x 50% of bushels)	MFP payment difference for using federal shrink chart
25,000	14.5%	24,550	24,250	300 bu	\$0.825	<u>\$247.50</u>

Included in the email addition of this newsletter are helpful excel worksheets that will properly shrink your loads according to federal shrink charts. All that is required to complete each worksheet is to complete the Gross, Tare, and Moisture Column.

2017 / 2018 ARC Co. Payments

FSA's ARC County program for the 2017 / 2018 crop year is projecting small payments, if any at all for corn and beans in most Ohio counties. The 2017/18

payment will be paid in the fall on 85% of the base acres only. No adjustments were made for any sequestration cuts or for crops planted on non-base acres.
